### Structure of the Bible


#### **OLD TESTAMENT**

- Covers 4000 plus years


#### **NEW TESTAMENT**







#### Between the Testaments



## The Unity of Scripture

- The Bible was written by nearly 40 authors, in three different languages, on three different continents, over a period of more than 1,500 years.
- Yet it manifests an amazing unity because of the single mind that inspired its writing, the Holy Spirit.

# The Unity of Scripture

- That unity can be demonstrated by studying the themes that are progressively revealed:
  - God
  - Christ/Messiah
  - The biblical covenants
  - The kingdom
  - Redemption

#### The Value of God's Word

- "There are three psalms that focus directly on the Scriptures as the means of living a righteous life before God: Pss 1; 19; and 119. Each of them is followed within the book by a unit that focuses on the coming Messiah: Pss 2; 20; 120-134 (the Psalms of Ascents). It is as if the composer of the book of Psalms were telling the readers that if they search the Scriptures, they will find the Christ."

## Heeding God's Word, Psalm 119

#### A. THE BLESSING OF FOCUS, VV. 9-12

- Heeding God's Word results in cleansing, v. 9
- Failure to heed God's Word results in wandering, v. 10
- Memorising God's Word provides protection, v. 11
- Praying to God brings understanding, v. 12

#### B. The blessing of expression, vv. 13-14

- Speaking God's Word, v. 13
- Rejoicing in God's Word, v. 14

#### C. The blessing of determination, vv. 15-16

- I will meditate on Your Word, v. 15a
- I will contemplate Your ways, v .15b
- I will delight in Your statutes, v. 16a
- I will not forget Your word, v. 16b
